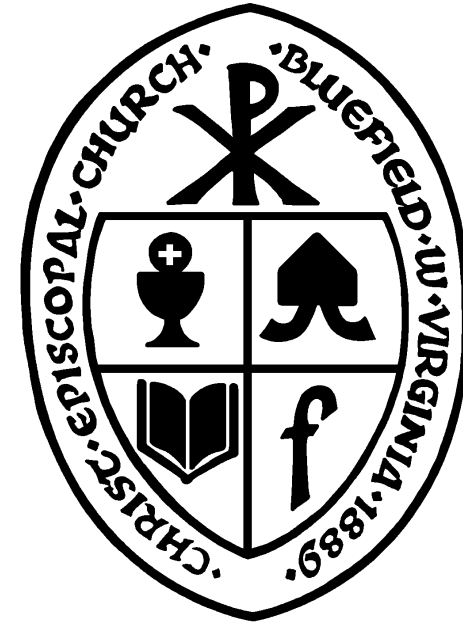
CHRISTMAS OUTREACH 2006
