Bless them in their dying and in their rising again in you.

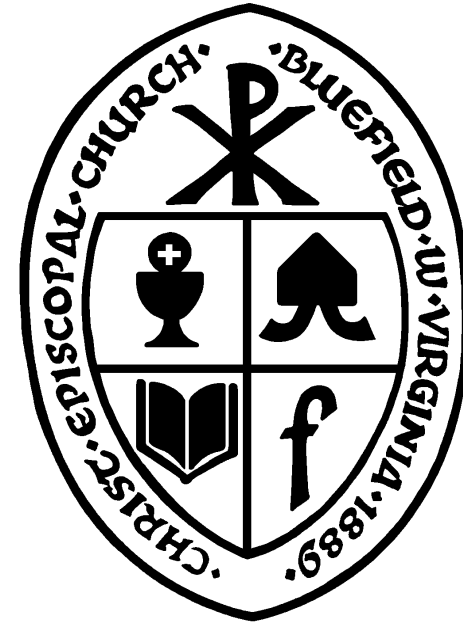
God of all consolation, we pray for those whose hearts
