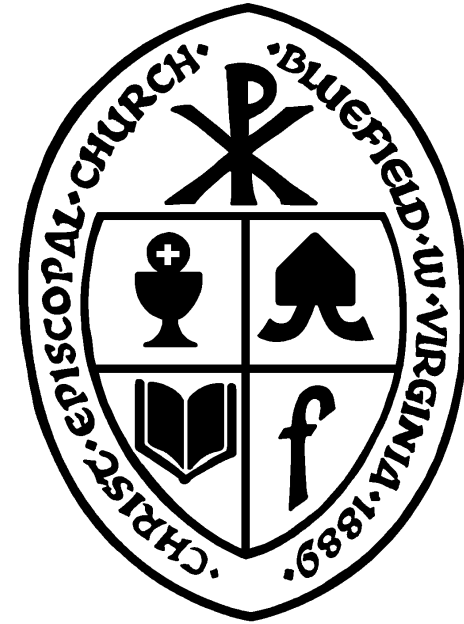
The Search Committee will meet, Tuesday, February 13th at the church. All committee members are urged to attend .
