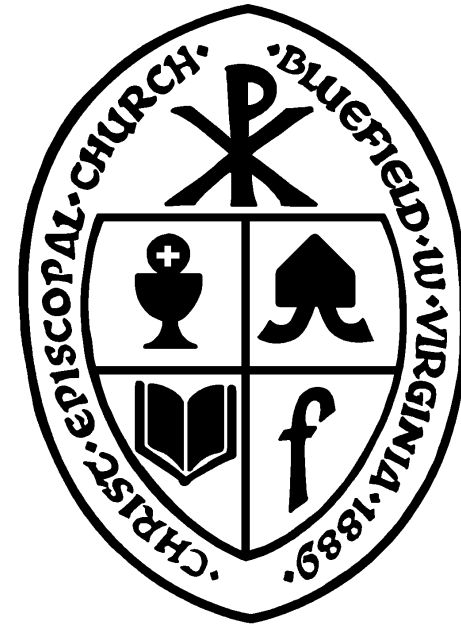
EASTER LILY SIGN-UP SHEET is on table in Narthex. Please add your name to the list so the flowers can be ordered for you.
