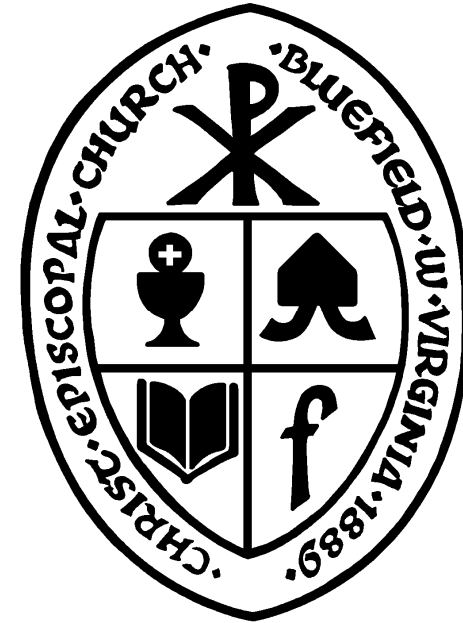
Bluefield Garden Tour on Sunday – August 19th from 1-5 p.m.
