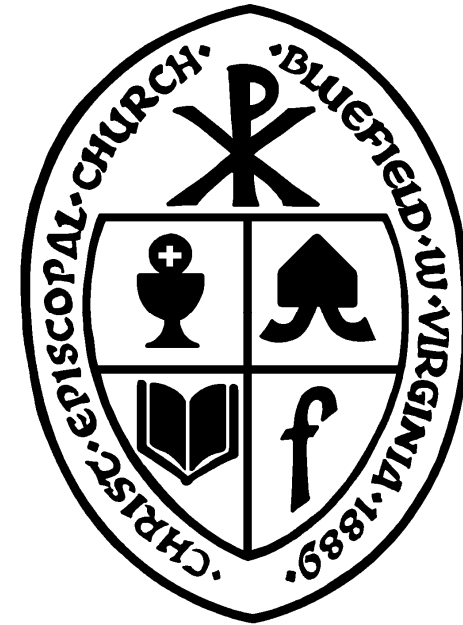
We need **Coffee Hosts and Ushers** for **August, September, and, October.** Please sign up!
