CEC FALL CONCERT INFORMATION

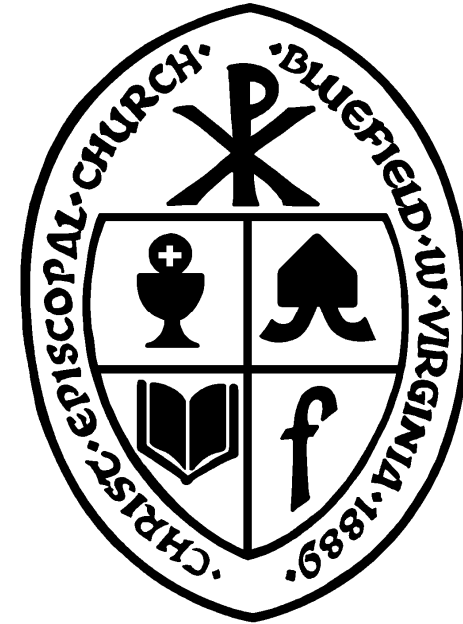
Concert will be held on Friday, October 31, at 12 noon with pianist **Min Kyung Kim**, sponsored by Bluefield College at CEC.
