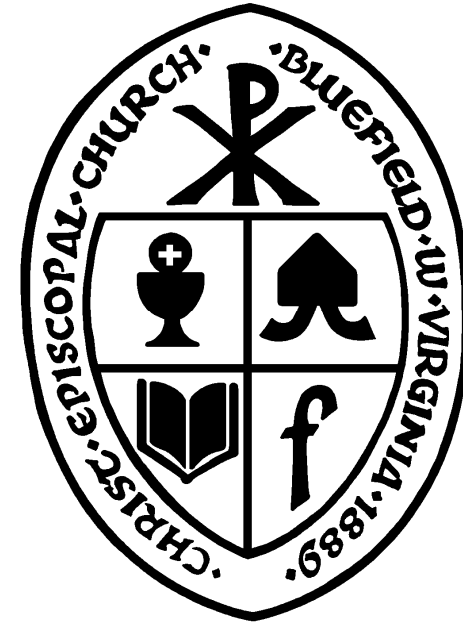
The **sign-up sheet** for the **American Red Cross Blood Mobile Drive**, on **June 5**, is located in the Narthex. Please sign up to help!
