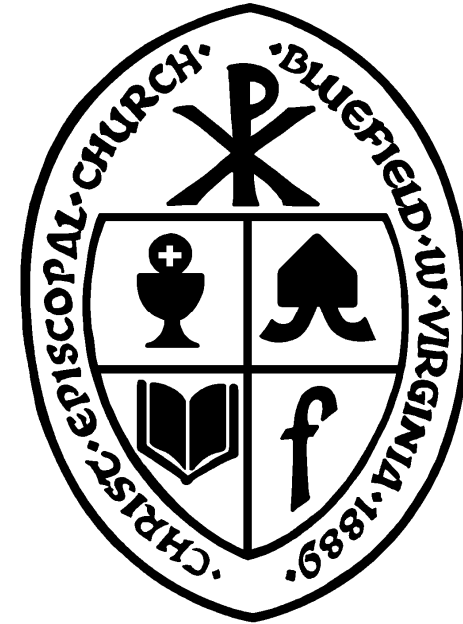
Please remember to place **donated clothing** and **canned food** for our **Food Pantry** in collection baskets located in Narthex hallway. Donations are always needed and welcome!
