CHRISMON TREE: We will need help decorating the Chrismon Tree on Saturday, November 28 at 10:00 a.m.

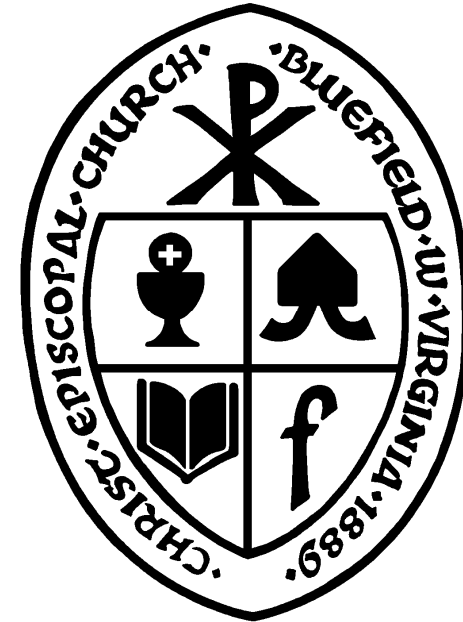
