**Godly Play** and the **Amazing Bible Race** begin each Sunday at 9:00 a.m. **Children's Chapel** begins at 10:00 a.m.

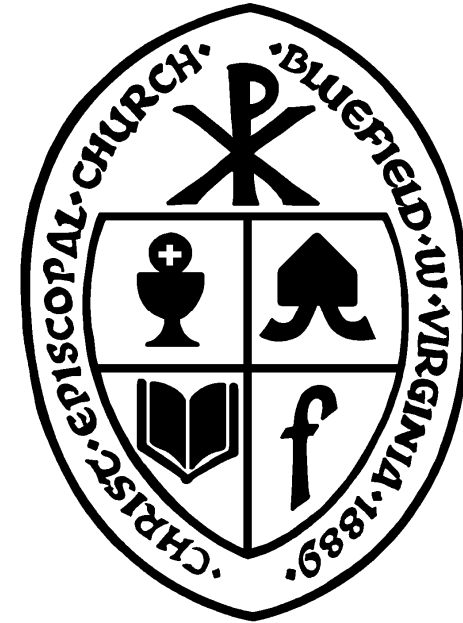
