Father Snider will be on vacation June 21 thru June 27th. **In case of emergency, please contact our Sr. Warden, Peter Richardson.**

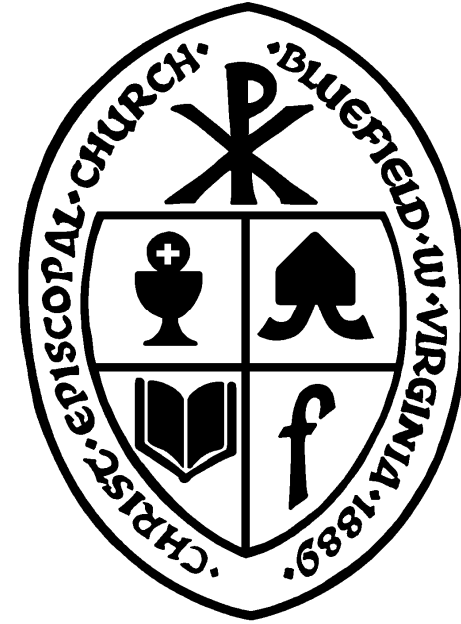
