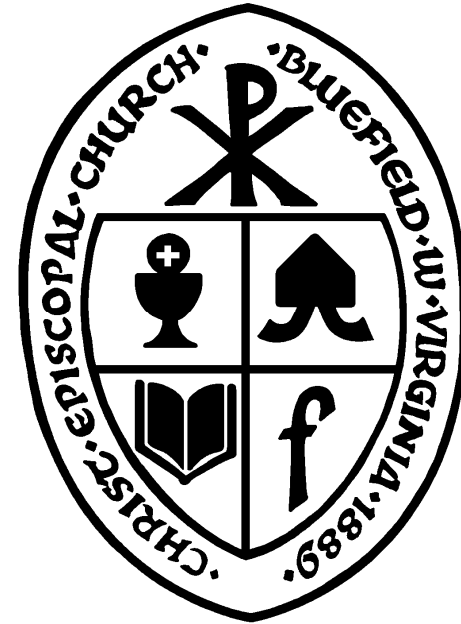
A Prayer for the Fourth
