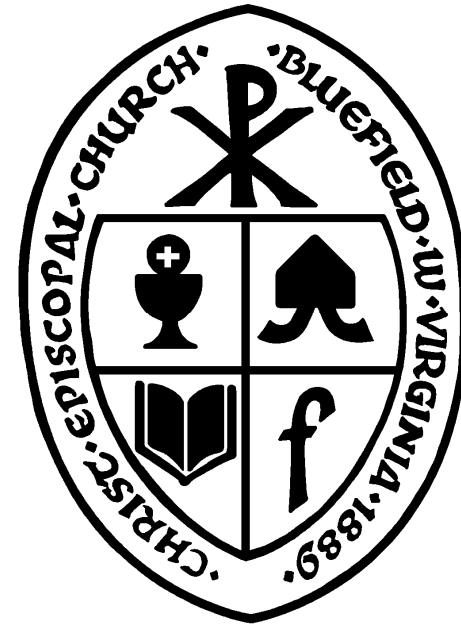
Amazing Bible Race: Solomon's Singers closed the gap a little this week. St. Paul is winning 2731-2558/The teams continue in Proverbs.
